Money raised will be used for the following:

- Reduce the cost of field trips. Bussing costs have almost tripled since last year. To reduce the burden on families, money raised from the Catholic Schools Walk will be used to help pay for buses.
- Playground equipment and improvements, such as new game equipment, structure repairs and/or replacement.
- Outdoor reflection area and outdoor classroom seating, additions to the area such as boards.
- Technology for classrooms, such as new chromebooks, tablets, and laptops.

On Friday, October 13, students at Divine Mercy will participate in our own version of the walk at school. Save the date for our "Rollin' for Soles" bowling event on Saturday, October 13, 2023. Families and friends can join us for only \$10 a person! Cost includes the cost of bowling for two and a half hours and shoes (more information to follow). Amazing raffle baskets will also be available. All proceeds from this event and raffles will also be donated to our Catholic Schools Walk fund.
