Catholic Schools Walk is an annual fundraising walk geared towards building community within our Catholic schools, celebrating Catholic education and helping all of the Catholic schools within the Archdiocese raise money to support educational costs. All proceeds raised at our school are kept within the school; that means 100% of the money raised comes to our school! Our goal this year is to raise \$9,000! We know we can do it. Money raised will be used for the following:

Reduce the cost of field trips. Bussing costs have almost tripled since last year. To reduce the burden on families, money raised from the Catholic Schools Walk will be used to help pay for buses.

Playground equipment and improvements, such as new game equipment, structure repairs and/or replacement.

Outdoor reflection area and outdoor classroom seating, additions to the area such as whiteboards.

Technology for classrooms, such as new chromebooks, tablets, and laptops.

For each level achieved towards our fundraising goal, students will earn an incentive. Check out these cool incentives:
