All proceeds raised at our school are kept within the school; that means 100% of the money raised comes to our school! Our goal this year is to raise \$9,000! We know we can do it. Money raised will be used for the following:

Reduce the cost of field trips. Bussing costs have almost tripled since last year. To reduce the burden on families, money raised from the Catholic Schools Walk will be used to help pay for buses.

Playground equipment and improvements, such as new game equipment, structure repairs and/or replacement.

Outdoor reflection area and outdoor classroom seating, additions to the area such as whiteboards.

Technology for classrooms, such as new chromebooks, tablets, and laptops.

For each level achieved towards our fundraising goal, students will earn an incentive. Check out these cool incentives:

Parking Lot Reminders

When entering and leaving the parking lot, be aware of your speed. Enter and exit the lot going no more than 10 mph for the safety of all. All vehicles must come to a stop when leaving the parking lot, either on College Avenue or St. Sylvester Drive, as there is oncoming traffic. There have been a number of complaints from our surrounding neighborhood recently about cars not obeying the stop signs at the end of the parking lot on St. Sylvester Drive as well as blocking driveways along Badger Avenue.
