Catholic Schools Week

Catholic Schools Week (CSW) begins on Sunday, January 28. Join us for our special Mass at 9:30 to kick the week off! Through the remainder of the week, students will have the opportunity to celebrate Catholic education in a variety of ways. Each day has a theme, where students are able to dress up. Students may wear their uniforms for days as well. Below is more information about each theme day and what to wear:

- Monday 1/29 "Guess Who- Divine Mercy!": Students may wear Divine Mercy Spirit shirts or hoodies (items purchased from Divine Mercy Spirit Store), soccer or basketball jerseys (this includes jerseys for our combined teams), red or black with out of uniform bottoms (no sweat pants, leggings, or athletic pants).
 - Tuesday 1/20 "Get a Clue": Students wearing their designated colors. Students may wear leggings with a shirt that falls mid thigh or sweat pants in their designated color.
 - Wednesday 1/31 "Dress Up Day" : Students may dress up in their Sunday best. Please refrain from wearing high heels.
 - Thursday 2/1 "Ready Battle Ship": Students may wear camouflage shirts and pants. No weapons or violence. Sweat pants, cargo pants, or leggings with a shirt that falls mid thigh are allowed.
 - Friday 2/2 "Level Up": Students may dress as their favorite game, game character or piece, or someone from a classic video game such as Frogger, Pac Man, Sonic, Donkey Kong, Mario. Students may wear sweatpants, leggings with shirts that fall mid thigh, onesie, or hoodie for their costume. No violence, anime, or weapons; costumes must be school appropriate (e.g. not tight, revealing).
