

General Reminders for the Parking Lot

Safety of all our families, students and parishioners is our top priority. Recently there have been a number of cars that have been driving recklessly through the parking lot at drop off and pick up. Please adhere to the following expectations when entering, driving, and exiting through our parking lot:

- <u>SLOW DOWN!</u> Speeds should not exceed 15 MPH. Driving slowly through the lot is for the safety of all!
- When exiting the driveways, **STOP**. Traffic on College Avenue and St. Sylvester Drive has the right of way.
- When driving through the lot, be aware of drivers in all of the lanes. Please do not cut across lanes, rather use the farthest driving lane (near the grassy area) to drive to a lane closest to the cross walk.
- When walking students through the parking lot, use the crosswalk area. DO NOT walk in front of cars in the
 drop off line or walk across the parking lot. Hold your child's hand (if younger) as you walk through the lot.
 Students should always be attended by an adult when walking in the parking lot.
- Drop off line parents may let their children out of the car before they arrive at the crosswalk/main sidewalk. This will help to keep the line moving efficiently and quickly.
- Again, the help of all is needed to keep our students, families and parishioners safe! Please do your part and be aware.

Forward

Forward testing has begun! The Forward Exam helps schools understand how students are progressing towards proficiency towards state academic standards across multiple curricular areas. The test is an online test. Students in fourth and eighth grade will take tests in English Language Arts (ELA), mathematics, social studies and science. Students in third and fifth through seventh will take tests in ELA and mathematics. Exam results are shared with families in the fall. Below is a schedule of when students are expected to take the exams. Please note that it takes a number of days to complete the tests as multiple breaks are provided. Children who are absent during testing will need to make up tests.

Test schedule:

- Monday, March 18- Wednesday, March 27 4th & 8th grade in progress!
- Tuesday, April 9-Friday, April 12 3rd & 5th grade
- Monday, April 15- Friday, April 19 6th & 7th grade
- Monday, April 22- Thursday, April 25 Make-up exams
