

# Registration

Registration numbers are used to help determine budget and staffing for the upcoming year. **Registration is available on a first come basis**. K3 is capped at 20 students and K4-8th are capped at 25 students per class. There are some classes that are nearing the cap. The window for applying to the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program closes on Thursday, April 18. All documentation required, such as residency verifications or income verifications, need to be to the school office by 3:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 18. **There are a number of individuals that are in need of returning items. If documentation is not in by Thursday. April 18 at 3:00 p.m. your application will not be verified or completed and your choice seat will be lost. Please note all registrations must be submitted online (there are no paper registrations). A registration form must be filled out for each child in your family.**
